OutsideView 9.1 Fixes

ID Title

- 6555 Change default password for SQL login "ovuser" to make it more complex.
- 6556 Dynamic Toolbar broken for Tedit.
- 6577 SFTP EXEC command causes OutsideView to abend if the user logon fails.
- 6598 OutsideView crashes on startup if the Windows Management Interface is disabled or not running.

Outstanding Issues

• If you are using **single-use passwords** for FTP/SFTP/FTPS file transfers, you cannot mix single-use password sessions with multi-use password sessions in the same OutsideView workspace. If you need to have both session types running at the same time, create a second iteration of OutsideView to segregate them.
